Among other deals, Mr. Bosch has been involved with the execution and financing of Cintra's noteworthy infrastructure projects such as the \$2.7 billion LBJ Express managed lanes project in Dallas, Texas, the \$2.1 billion North Tarrant Express managed lanes project in Fort Worth, Texas, the \$648 million I-77 Express Lanes project in Charlotte, North Carolina, and the \$1 billion Highway 407 East extension phase 1 and the \$1.2 billion Highway 407 East extension phase 2 in Toronto, Ontario.

Most recently, he led the structuring and financing of Cintra's more than \$3.5 billion I-66 Express Lanes project in Northern Virginia which reached financial close in November 2017.

Mr. Bosch holds a master's degree in finance and management from the University of Exeter in the United Kingdom. He also has a bachelor's degree in civil industrial engineering from the Universidad de Chile.
